From the clues below, can you determine which student was responsible for which items, what grade they were in, and where the items belonged?

1. Derek is in grade (32 / 8)
2. Erin did not put away the textbooks or open the cupboard
3. The student who put away the calculators was in grade (45 / 9)
4. Cindy and Erin are the oldest and the youngest of the students.
5. Boys put away the rulers and the textbooks, but neither of these were stored in the closet or the Teacher's desk
6. The thing that Erin put away on the shelf can be used to add and subtract numbers.
7. The student in grade (9-2x3) put the rulers away in the filing cabinet.
8. The tools used for measuring angles were put back in the closet.
